


#### Page 2 Narrative - Monte Cristo Guzzler Big Game Water Development Project

- 1. Project Goals and Measurable Outcomes: Jason Salisbury, Nevada Department of Wildlife Biologist in charge of the Monte Cristo Mountains in Nye County, states as follows: "This water development was an emergency build based upon the number of bighorn sheep that occupy the range (60+) and the available water. The current drought conditions and forage conditions in 2012 will require a greater consumption of water resources. It was feared that the one known spring would dry up this year leading to stranded bighorn sheep in the area. This unit could not be built earlier because it was not cleared through the BLM. We built this water development as soon as we could as a precautionary measure to ensure the safety of the bighorn sheep located in the area." The specific goal of this project was to provide a stable water source for the at-risk population of bighorn sheep in the Monte Cristo Mountains. Measurable outcomes will be through observation and documentation of bighorn sheep utilizing this water source, and the monitoring of the general health of the bighorn sheep herds in the area. Additional benefit will be seen with other wildlife species utilizing this water source.
- 2. Project location: Monte Cristo Mountains in Nye County, Nevada. Utm Nad 83 11S 403272 4315713.
- 3. Project descripton: The construction of a big game guzzler of the following criteria: Apron size: 3000 square feet. Water tank holding capacity: 3 x 2,400 gallon tanks, total capacity of 7,200 gallons. Drinker: custom fabricated double access stainless steel drinker. Fencing: 336 feet of 2-rail fencing around the drinker, fence posts set in concrete. Barb wire fencing around the apron for protection of the apron. Upon completion of the project, filling the 3 storage tanks to the 7,200 gallon capacity with a water truck to allow for immediate access to water for wildlife. Map included on page 3.
- 4. Permitting: Categorical exclusion was provided to NDOW by the Carson City field office of the Stillwater District of the BLM. This exclusion was based upon emergency need and was obtained prior to construction of the project.
- 5. Future phases of this project: None.
- 6. Principals involved: The Nevada Department of Wildlife and Nevada Bighorns Unlimited.
- 7. Number of Staff Positions Involved: For NDOW, 4 full-time staff positions for the duration of the project. For NBU, no paid staff positions.
- 8. Number of volunteers: For Saturday, July 14<sup>th</sup>, 50 volunteers. For Sunday, July 15<sup>th</sup>, 25 volunteers. Hours for Saturday, 600. Hours for Sunday, 150.
- 9. Timeline: This project is completed. July 9-13, 2012, NDOW performed preparation of the site (dirt work) and delivery of materials. Water development construction on July 14-15, 2012. Filling of the tanks with a water truck, end of the day July 14<sup>th</sup>.
- 10. Success: Success will be determined when the motion-activated cameras are installed at the site to document wildlife, particularly bighorn sheep, using the water development. These cameras are not installed yet. Additional information will be obtained as Jason Salisbury and others visit this site and monitor the general condition of the bighorn sheep herds in the area. On a side note, songbirds were noted using the site on Sunday, July 14th and documented photographically.






