Narrative

Santa Rosa Population Management Unit Restoration and Rehabilitation Project

Porcupine Fire Segment

1) Specific Project Goals and Measurable Outcomes:

The restoration and rehabilitation of prime Sage grouse habitats within the noted Population management Unit (PMU). This segment (Porcupine Fire Rehabilitation) is part of a larger landscape effort with multi-faceted efforts from multiple partners (See Item 6 below). This specific segment seeks to restore 155 acres to functional Sage grouse rearing habitat in as short an amount of time as possible. The specific area is part of the "Porcupine Fire" which removed critical vegetative components.

2) Project Location:

The project is located primarily on the Santa Rosa Ranger District, Humboldt -Toiyabe National Forest, Nevada. This project is located within the Santa Rosa Population Management Unit (PMU) for the greater Sage grouse. This PMU is located predominately within the confines of the above noted Ranger District. The PMU is also inclusive of private and BLM lands, and seeks to obtain results at a "landscape" level. The area is entirely within Humboldt County, Nevada and within the boundaries of the Paradise / Sonoma Conservation District.

3) Project Description:

The Sage-Grouse population located in the Santa Rosa PMU is the largest in a PMU in the State of Nevada and is therefore a benchmark population (approximately 7500). The bulk of the quality habitat in the Santa Rosa PMU lies predominately on lands managed by the US Forest Service (USFS). The problem in many of the Sage Grouse habitats is not only habitat loss, in this case by wildfire, but a lack of funding to prevent and mitigate such habitat loss. Traditionally this funding has been provided primarily by the federal government. Such funding has dwindled over the last decade.

This project will restore full functionality of 155 acres of Sage grouse rearing habitat which has been essentially lost due to the Porcupine fire. Rehabilitation will be through manual seeding and aerial seeding of native species as well as manual planting of seedling stock.

4) Permitting:

Required NEPA work has been accomplished through a categorical exclusion. The project requires funding only for materials and some labor.

5) Future Phases:

None are envisioned other than ongoing monitoring
